52 CHANGE Agents

CUNY Students, from York & Medgar Evers Colleges, received 1,325 hours of mentoring and training in HIV/STI/STD Awareness & Prevention Education, Facilitation, Presentation and Workplace Readiness Skills, to become Peer Educators and Community Activists for Adolescent Sexual Health

4,586 High School & College Students, and Community Members

Participated in 482 workshops at schools, colleges, health fairs, churches, conferences and special events in Brooklyn & Queens

> 3,498 Participants given HIV Test Referrals

> > 707 Participants Tested for HIV

541 Participants given STI Testing/Screening Referrals

> 75 Participants Tested/Screened for STI
