Elevate young people's voices through our mentorship model, designed to support young people ages 16-18 with paid mentorships (funded by STNYC)



Provide a mentee with an opportunity of a life time, with a commitment of 1-2 hours a week of mentoring over 10 weeks in 2021



Connect to a network of industry professionals passionate about equity

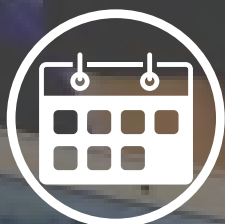
