## 6 Years of Community Activism for Adolescent Sexual Health

From the Fall of 2010 to the Spring of 2016,  
CUNY-CAT's Project CHANGE has had the following impact:

### 52 CHANGE Agents

CUNY Students, from York & Medgar Evers Colleges, received 1,325 hours of mentoring and training in HIV/STI/STD Awareness & Prevention Education, Facilitation, Presentation and Workplace Readiness Skills, to become Peer Educators and Community Activists for Adolescent Sexual Health

### 4,586 High School & College Students, and Community Members

Participated in 482 workshops at schools, colleges, health fairs, churches, conferences and special events in Brooklyn & Queens

3,498
